On Sunday 3rd November 214 runners took to the fields/woods/parks and bridleways of Offerton for the inaugural Fairway Five Trail Race. Harry Hind from Stockport Harriers won the race with a blistering time of 29 mins 50 second, Emilia Platt from Salford Harriers won the ladies race with an equally impressive time of 31 minutes 47 seconds coming 3rd overall. The fiercely contested fastest Fairway parents race was won by John Irvine and Lauren Massingham. The fastest teacher competition was won by Miss England. Former Fairway Primary student Dave Hatch came 6th overall, congratulations to all of you!

This event was put together with the intention of raising money for the school without relying on parents having to attend the event. The majority of runners had no connection to our school with runners coming from 37 different running clubs. This event was a massive team "Fairway Primary" event, and we just could not have done it without the help of all our parents. We had 22 marshall points and people helping out with other roles such as set up, registration, bag drop, car parking, refreshments amongst other roles. On behalf of myself and the organising team can I say a massive thank you to every single person that was involved, feedback from the runners has been fantastic.
