- Unused cosmetics

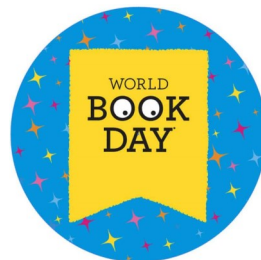
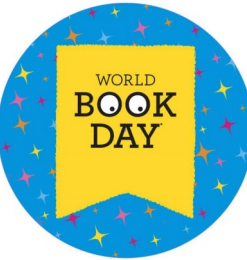
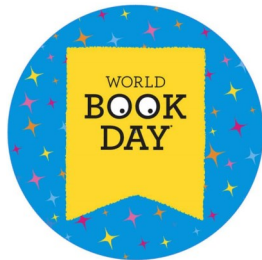
Bring your full bags to school by Wednesday 25th February 2026. This will help us raise money for school as well as this amazing charity.

Get ready to bring vocabulary to life! This year, we are celebrating **World Book Day** on **Thursday, 5th March**.

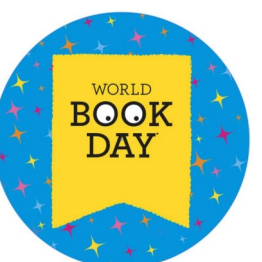
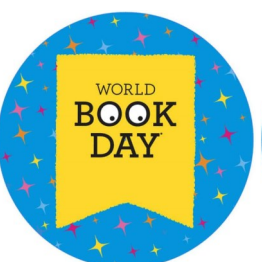
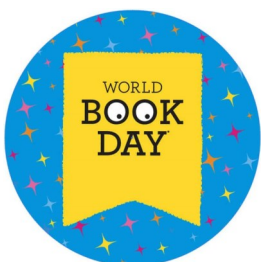
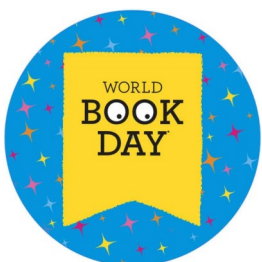
Instead of just dressing as a specific book character (although you can do that too!), we are challenging all children and grown ups to **come dressed as an adjective!**
