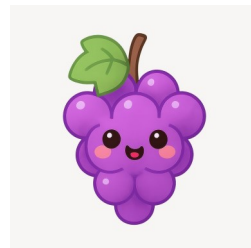
Come on England!!!

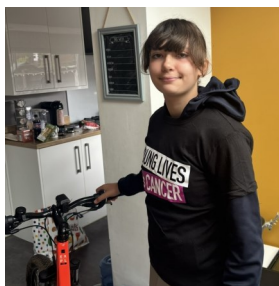
